

More Cutting: -

From the background fabric

Cut 6 strips, $8\frac{1}{2}$ " then crosscut into 4, $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $28\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles,
4, $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles,
4, $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
and 4, $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

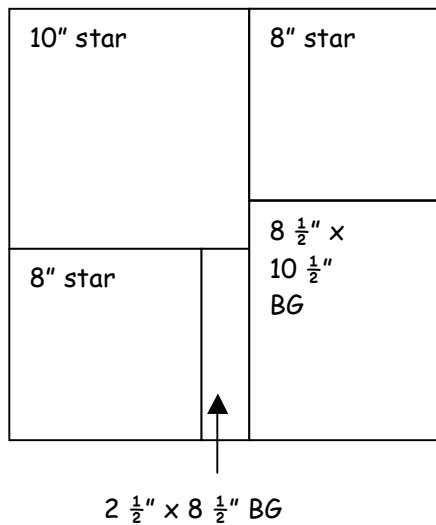
Cut 2 strips, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " then crosscut into 16, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

Cut 1 strip, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " then crosscut into 4, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.

Putting it all together:-

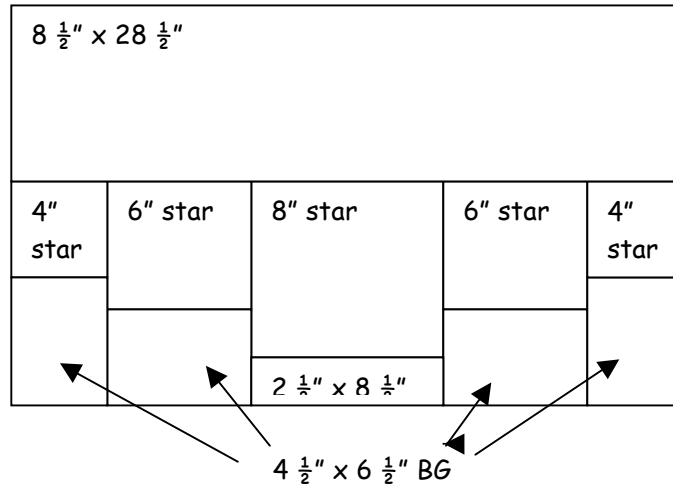
Section 1:- Corner unit - Make 4

You will need a 10" star, 2, 8" stars, 1, $2\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $8\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle of BG fabric and 1, $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $10\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle of BG fabric for each corner.



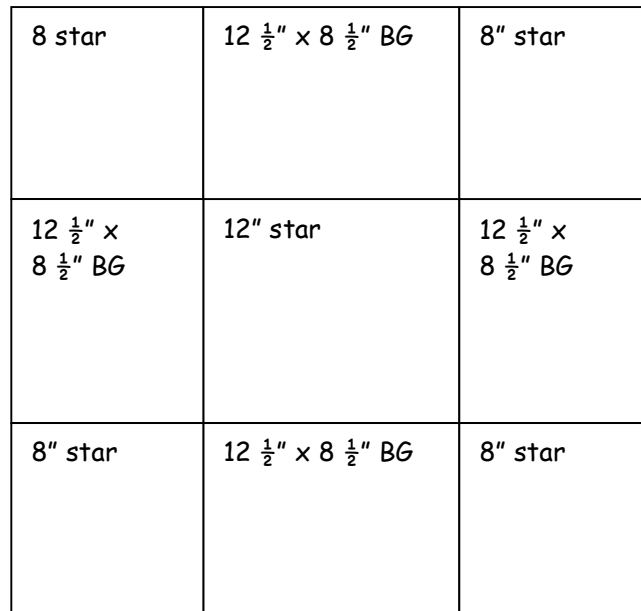
Section 2:- Side pieces - make 4.

You will need 1, 8" star, 2, 6" stars, 2, 4" stars, 1, $8\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle and 4, $6\frac{1}{2}$ " \times $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.



Section 3:- Centre.

You will need 1, 12" star, 4, 8 "stars and 4, $12 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 8 \frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles BG.



Now follow the diagram to put these sections together.

Border: -

1. Cut 7 strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
2. Join all the strips together to have one continuous strip, press.
3. Measure through the centre of the quilt and cut 2 strips to this measurement.
4. Attach these strips to opposite sides of the quilt. Press.
5. Measure the quilt through the centre including these new strips, cut 2 strips to this measurement.
6. Attach to the quilt.

Give your quilt a final press and congratulate your self on a job well done.

Finishing: -

Layer backing, wadding and quilt top and quilt as desired.

Binding: -

Binding can be done in any colour you wish, however I suggest using more of your stash and cutting random lengths of fabrics and joining them together.
